Athletes of the Meet

Trevor Turner—was determined to make it back to Finals and his performance showed that with a drop of 5.4 seconds in 200 Free and 9.8 seconds in 500 free

Charlie Chang—after hovering around the State qualifying time all season he finally broke that barrier (in a big way) with his drop of over 10 seconds in his 500 free

Aidan Sweeney—placed 3rd in 200IM after dropping an impressive 3 seconds from a previous quality time. Also placed 2nd in 500 free after a drop of 8.3 seconds

Cassie Wilhelm— she didn't seem real happy when she found out the events she had been entered in for the meet. Her performance definitely did not show this lack of enthusiasm though. She placed 7th in both events after drops of 11.2 seconds in her 500 free and 2.0 seconds in her 200 free

Anna Springer— after many ups and downs throughout the season she pulled together two nice performances when the team needed it most. She dropped .4 seconds in her 50 free and nearly 2 seconds in her 100 breaststroke.
